North and East Texas County Judges and Commissioners,

As the economy has become a daily topic in most of our lives, we know that costs, especially in education, change daily also. With that in mind, the North and East Texas County Judges and Commissioners Association is now accepting applications for the awarding of scholarships for children or grandchildren of current county judges and commissioners.

College scholarships in the amount of \$1,500, \$1,250 and \$1,000 will be awarded to three applicants during the annual conference in Waco on July 21.

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, each applicant must be a child, grandchild, or student under the legal guardianship of a current judge or commissioner. Each of the applicants must be a current resident of a county within the 74-member county region. Each must be a graduating high school senior for the class of 2025 or pursuing an undergraduate degree at a four-year university.

Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

- Personal résumé
- Letters of reference (3)
- Official transcript
- Completed application form

The scholarship's funds are not derived from tax dollars collected from member dues. Instead, funding comes from previous conference proceeds, not at taxpayer expense.

All entries are to be submitted to North and East Texas CJCA Immediate Past President Wade McKinney for Scholarship Committee consideration. All entries are to be received or postmarked by 5 p.m. on July 1, 2025. Entries are to be sent to:

GENERAL INFORMATION

The scholarship application is to be used for scholarships awarded by North and East Texas County Judges and Commissioners' Association (NETCJCA). All scholarship applications must be submitted to the chair of the NETCJCA Scholarship Committee on the approved form either by hand delivery, electronic format * (PDF) or **postmarked by 5 p.m., July 1, 2025**.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate the overall comprehensiveness of the application.

ELIGIBILITY

The NETCJCA is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to a child or grandchild of an active member of the association.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

All applications must adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Submit a completed scholarship application. Incomplete applications may not be considered.
- 2. The president of the NETCJCA will appoint a Scholarship Committee to review the applications and make the selection.
- 3. Any application received by the Scholarship Committee chair postmarked after the date of **July 1** shall not be considered by the Committee (electronic PDF application accepted by 5 p.m. on deadline date).
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded at the annual conference of the NETCJCA.
- The student's grade average should be considered, but the grades should not be the only factor considered. The needs of
 the student, whether the student is receiving any other scholarships, the student's sincere desire to attend college, and
 any other similar information should be considered.
- 6. Each recipient will be officially notified in writing by the Scholarship Committee chair, Wade McKinney.
- 7. Upon proof of enrollment to an institution of higher education, a check will be issued to the scholarship recipient.
- 8. Scholarships must be utilized during the fall semester following award.
